The product, TR-ClarifEYE™, an innovative veterinary glaucoma implant marketed by TR BioSurgical, LLC (TRBIO), is scheduled for limited market launch in April 2009.

Healionics' proprietary STAR – Sphere Templated Angiogenic Regeneration – is a biomaterial scaffold designed to enhance bio-integration and promote healing of implanted medical devices. In addition to the veterinary ophthalmic market, Healionics currently has numerous research agreements in place evaluating STAR biomaterial in multiple human market applications including aesthetics, obesity management, diabetes care, advanced wound care, chronic pain management, end stage renal disease, and long-term infusion care.
